## Level 2 Award for Working as a Door Supervisor within the Private Security Industry

---

This regulated qualification is ideal for anyone wishing to work as a door supervisor as it provides them with the necessary skills and knowledge to apply for an SIA Licence in this field. Subjects covered include behavioural standards, legislation relevant to the role, search procedures, powers of arrest, recording incidents and crime scene preservation, reducing risk, conflict management, communicating effectively and physical intervention.

### **How long will it take me to achieve this qualification?**

This qualification must be undertaken over a minimum of **4-days**. If Home Learning is completed prior to starting the course

### **How is the qualification assessed?**

It is divided into 4-units and is assessed through 3 multiple-choice examinations, 1-written test and a practical test. These units are as follows:

#### **Unit 1: Working in the Private Security Industry**

Assessed by a multiple-choice examination of 1-hour consisting of 40-questions. Learners must achieve a score of at least 28 out of 40 to pass this unit.

#### **Unit 2: Working as a Door Supervisor within the Private Security Industry**

Assessed by a multiple-choice examination of 1-hour 15-minutes and consisting of 45-questions. Learners must achieve a score of at least 32 out of 45 to pass this unit.

#### **Unit 3: Conflict Management within the Private Security Industry**

Assessed by a multiple-choice examination of 30-minutes and consisting of 20-questions. Learners must achieve a score of at least 14 out of 20 to pass this unit.

**Unit 4: Physical Intervention Skills within the Private Security Industry** - Assessed in two parts. Part one is a practical test and part two is a written test set by the Awarding Body. Learners must achieve a 100% pass mark in both tests.
