FPOS-I also known as First Person On Scene - Intermediate, has been designed to equip learners with the skills, knowledge and confidence to help a person in a life threatening situation.

FPOS is designed for those who are likely to be first on the scene of an emergency incident when a person's life is in danger, such as community responders, fire and police personnel, industrial first aiders and those who want to achieve more than First Aid.

This qualification has been developed with the NHS Ambulance Services and is clinically endorsed by the Faculty of Pre-Hospital Care. FPOS also meets the Security Industry Authority first aid requirements for Close Protection Operatives.

MIRA Level 4 takes you one step further in your Medical Knowledge to deal with situations you are likely to encounter in the wild or within a tactical environment. MIRA is approved by the Royal College of Surgeons and Industry Qualifications (IQ) at level 4

## **How long will it take me to achieve this qualification?**

It is recommended that the qualification is delivered over **5 days**

## **How are the qualifications assessed?**

- This qualification is assessed by a multiple-choice question (MCQ) examination.
